POLICY TITLE	Uniform Policy
RESPONSIBLE COMMITTEE	Education Advisory Board (EAB)
RATIONALE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • That all children wear the academy uniform when attending the academy, are representing the academy, or when participating in an academy organised event outside normal school hours.
PURPOSES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Promotes a sense of pride in the academy • Engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the academy • Is practical and smart • Identifies the children within the academy • Prevents children from coming to the academy in 'fashion' wear which could be distracting to learning • Makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance • Is regarded as suitable wear for academy life, and good value for money by most parents • Is designed with health and safety in mind
GUIDELINES	<p><u>The role of parents</u></p> <p>We ask all parents to support the uniform policy; as it is parents' responsibility to ensure children wear the correct uniform, and that it is clean and in good repair. To minimise the event of clothing being lost, all clothing must be named, so if misplaced, it can be returned. In the event of misplaced clothing, staff will label any academy uniform.</p> <p><u>Uniform – Boys</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Trousers – black / grey • Polo Shirt – white (red in the nursery) • Jumper / Cardigan –red with academy logo / plain red • Y6 V-neck jumper, white collared shirt and tie <p><u>Uniform – Girls</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • As above, and... • Skirts – black / grey (must be at least knee length) • Summer Dresses –red and white gingham, or black / grey pinafore • Shorts may be worn under skirts and dresses, but must not be visible • Y6 V-neck jumper, white collared shirt and tie <p><u>Footwear</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Black, flat sole / covers toes (heels are not permitted) • In the event of bad /wet weather; wellington boots are advisable; however, children need a change of agreed academy footwear whilst indoors <p><u>P.E. Kit</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The academy provides an academy P.E. kit for Reception –Y6 pupils; which is laundered by the academy free of charge to parents, this remains the property of the academy at all times • Indoor P.E. – academy provided P.E. kit of red shorts and white t-shirt, bare feet • Outdoor P.E. – Academy P.E. kit can be worn, and covered by tracksuit bottoms and tracksuit top/jumper in colder weather. The tracksuit should not have bold print, logos or slogans; trainers. No hoodies allowed. • Long hair needs to be tied back <p><u>Jewellery/ make up: on health and safety grounds, children are not permitted to wear jewellery / make up at the academy except:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • agreed religious items • the only permitted body piercings are stud earrings (to be taken out for P.E. lessons, or covered with tape / plaster provided by parents) • functional watch / functional belt • false nails / nail extensions are not permitted • make up is not permitted • extreme hair colours and hairstyles are not permitted
